Other event this month: Tout Feu, tout Flamme Winter Festival from 10 February to 11 March in Le Perche (L'Orne).



The Granville Carnival will take place from 9th to 13th February in Granville (La Manche). A whole programme of festivities is planned during these days. Highlights include the satirical and humorous cavalcades gathering 45 floats and 3,000 exhibitors accompanied by music bands. The event ends with a confetti battle and the "death", after a mock trial of the Carnival king, a giant papier-mâché mascot.
