



What's on in Normandy?



La Fête du Sirop will be held from 10 to 14 October in Vire Normandie (Calvados). During this great event you'll be able to witness the making of the Norman "sirop" (jam made with cider), hear some traditional French music, and also learn more about Norman heritage through exhibitions, games and conferences. The link with the Channel Islands and mainland Normandy will be at centre stage with a talk by Jean Le Maistre and the launch of a CD-book on songs & music repertoire of the Channel Islands.

Bayeux-Calvados Award for war correspondents will take place from 8 to 14 October in Bayeux (Calvados). Its purpose is to recognize the work of war journalists, from around the world, in 4 categories: written press, radio, television and photography. In addition to the awards ceremony, many events are planned (book fair, exhibitions, meetings, debates...) to raise awareness on international conflicts and understand the reporters' work.
