The **Armada of Rouen** also known as The Armada of Freedom will be celebrating its 30<sup>th</sup> birthday and its 7<sup>th</sup> edition on the Quays of the Seine in **Rouen** (Seine-Maritime) from **June 6<sup>th</sup> to 16<sup>th</sup>**. 10 days of events, concerts, fireworks to celebrate the gathering of about 50 vessels amongst the most beautiful in the world.
