## What's on in Normandy?



The Hermione comes to Normandy. This magnificent, 65m long, tall ship is the only historical replica of an 18<sup>th</sup> century ship. She is based on the ship La Fayette took to America to join the fight for independence in 1780. You will be able to admire her in **Cherbourg** (Manche) from **May 4<sup>th</sup> to 8<sup>th</sup>**, in **Dieppe** (Seine-Maritime) from **May 11<sup>th</sup> to 13<sup>th</sup>**, in **Ouistreham** (Calvados) from **May 14<sup>th</sup> to 17<sup>th</sup>**.

The 2019 edition of the Normandy Channel Race will start on Sunday, May, 19<sup>th</sup> and finish on May 26<sup>th</sup>. It is an impressive and international nautical course spanning 1,000 miles and integrating the English Channel, the Celtic Sea and the Irish Sea, that sets off from and returns to the city of Caen (Calvados). This year will mark the 10<sup>th</sup> anniversary of the event that first set sail in the spring of 2010 from Caen.
