The Saint-Luc Fair taking place in Gavray from October 18<sup>th</sup> to 20<sup>th</sup> is one of the oldest fairs in the county of La Manche. It gathers every year more than 100,000 visitors who come to enjoy this traditional agricultural fair with 600 exhibitors: food stalls, games, animations... 2019 marks the 15<sup>th</sup> anniversary of the event inside the event: the pumpkin fair.

This year, the Norman Fair will celebrate Cinema on October 5<sup>th</sup> & 6<sup>th</sup>. Legendary cars will be on display such as Tim Burton Batmobile or the infamous DeLorean DMC-12 from Back to the Future, stunt demonstrations, conferences...

For two days, you will be able to walk around, taste and discover Norman products while enjoying some music, theatre and other cultural animations. On October 27<sup>th</sup>, you will be able to witness the departure of these boats from Le Havre (Seine-Maritime). They will then try to reach Salvador de Bahia in Brazil sailing more than 4350 miles.
