Out of 46 lawyers from 16 countries, 10 will be selected to participate in the finale at the Memorial Museum in Caen (Calvados) on January 26<sup>th</sup>. Candidates will have 12 minutes to plead their case relating to a genuine, individual case of human rights' violation from current affairs.
