

'**Chauffer dans la Noirceur**' is an eco-friendly music festival that has been taking place on the beach of **Montmartin-sur-Mer** (Manche) for 32 years. In 2024, the festival will bring artists and musicians together from **12 to 14 July** with free daytime art activities and evening concerts, all of this to enjoy with your feet in the sand!

From **5 to 7 July**, you will have the opportunity to shop from more than 150 stalls while enjoying historical reenactments that will transport you back to the Middle Ages.

The '**Tour des Ports de la Manche**' is a sailing race taking place from **7 to 12 July**. Every year, the event attracts around 500 participants. For the first time, the **race will begin in Jersey** on 7 July and continue on to Granville, Barneville-Carteret, Guernsey, Diélette, Cherbourg, before concluding in Saint-Vaast-la-Hougue on 12 July.
