The **D-Day Festival** returns to **Normandy's landing beaches from 31 May until 15 June.** Visitors can enjoy festive and cultural events including paratroopers' demonstrations, parades of military vehicles, fireworks, book fairs, exhibitions, reconstitutions of military camps, dances... Celebrating freedom is at the heart of the D-Day festival every year!
