In July, France will be celebrating its **Fête Nationale** on **14 July**. As tradition goes, firemen balls, concerts and fireworks are organised **all around the country** on 13 and/or 14 July. For example, Rouen (Seine-Maritime) hosts a ball just before the fireworks on the quays, Bagnoles-de-l'Orne (Orne) brings over street theatre and a musical parade... This festival will be the opportunity to discover, for free, performances in theatre, dance, music, puppeteers, circus acts...
