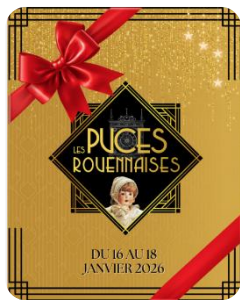

From **31 January to 15 February**, more than 80 cinemas and media libraries **across France** join forces around the theme of *Resilience*, with screenings ranging from *Train to Busan* and *Mad Max* to *Nausicaä of the Valley of the Wind*, alongside talks and encounters exploring possible futures.
