Every year, the French Ministry of Culture organises the event **Rendez-vous in the gardens** offering visitors the opportunity to explore more than 2,800 parks and gardens **across Europe**. With the 2026 theme focusing on “the view”, it was only fitting that the Channel Islands take part for the first time, with around 20 gardens opening in Jersey, Guernsey and Alderney from **5 to 7 June**. From **30 May until 14 June**, there will also be the **D-Day festival** with events organised along the coast and across Normandy to celebrate the freedom regained after the events of June 1944.
