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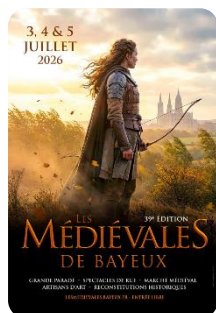
What's on in Normandy?

This year marks the centenary disappearance of Claude Monet, and for the first time, the entire programme is dedicated to contemporary art. This festival offers exhibitions, shows, and cultural events with the aim of highlighting the Norman territory and its impressionist heritage.

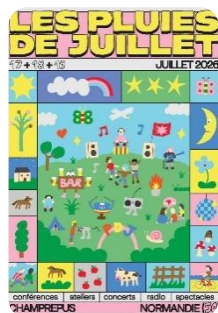
And also **A summer in Le Havre** from 27 June to 20 September in **Le Havre** (Seine-Maritime), **Les Sorties de Bain**, street arts festival, from 2 to 5 July in **Granville** (Manche), **Light show on the Bayeux Cathedral** from 14 July to 29 August (Calvados)



From 3 to 5 July, the Medieval Bayeux are coming back for their 39th edition. After fire, earth and water; this year, air is explored in all its forms for the festival. Wind instruments, legendary birds, glassblowers and other creatures from the sky will gather in Bayeux (Calvados) to celebrate the medieval history of the town.
