Les Médiévales de Bayeux are back from 1 to 3 July in Bayeux (Calvados) to celebrate their 35<sup>th</sup> edition! This free event will take you on a journey through medieval times with parades, street performances, a medieval market... With everyone encouraged to wear a period costume, be prepared to travel back in time!

Art Sonic will take place on 22 & 23 July in Briouze (Orne).

This year, the festival is celebrating its 25<sup>th</sup> anniversary and bringing big names to the stage such as Orelsan, Vald, Rone... Since 1996, this music festival has grown and became one of the biggest stages for French contemporary music in Normandy.

The **Linen and Artistic Fiber Festival** will celebrate its 30th anniversary on **8, 9 and 10 July!** Led by a team of 300 volunteers, it takes place over 3 days in 10 towns of the Dun Valley and its surroundings in Seine-Maritime. Discover the flax sector in all its forms through more than 30 exhibitions, fashion shows, guided tours and other types of events!

The **Tour des Ports de la Manche** is a regatta held every year which links 5 ports of the Manche department and the Channel Islands. This year it will take place from **3 to 8 July** and will be **in Jersey on 6 & 7**. On 7 July, instead of going to Guernsey and for the very first time, participants will race around the island of Jersey before heading to Granville on the 8<sup>th</sup>.
