


## What's on in Normandy?

Street performances festivals are one of the joys of summer in Normandy with artists competing in skill and creativity to enchant spectators. The Norman network for street performances called ReNAR promotes many festivals such as **Les Sorties de Bain** in **Granville** (Manche) from **6 to 9 July** or **Les Faltaisies** in **Falaise** (Calvados) from **22 to 30 July**.

**Les Pluies de Juillet** (July rains) is a festival committed to the issue of climate change taking place in **Le Tanu** (Manche) from **6 to 9 July**. This festival is an opportunity to discover talented artists while taking part in conversations around ecology, exchange good practices and increase one's knowledge via conferences led by local & national actors of the field.

The **Rolex Fastnet Race** is the world's largest offshore sailing race. The biennial 690 nautical mile race celebrates its 50<sup>th</sup> anniversary in 2023. More than 350 boats will start sailing from Cowes Isle of Wight and finish in **Cherbourg-en-Cotentin** (Manche) where a village will be set up and festivities held from **20 to 29 July**.
