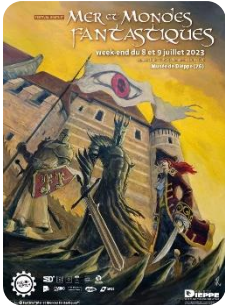




What's on in Normandy?

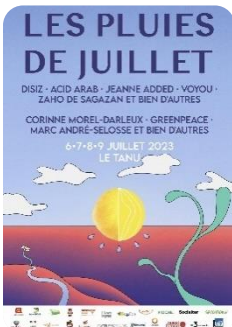

The Norman network for street performances called ReNAR promotes many festivals such as **Les Sorties de Bain** in **Granville** (Manche) from **6 to 9 July** or **Les Faltaisies** in **Falaise** (Calvados) from **22 to 30 July**.

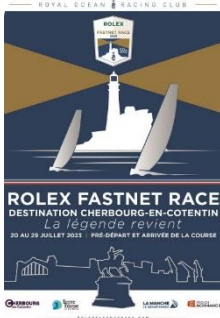

Les Pluies de Juillet (July rains) is a festival committed to the issue of climate change taking place in **Le Tanu** (Manche) from **6 to 9 July**. This festival is an opportunity to discover talented artists while taking part in conversations around ecology, exchange good practices and increase one's knowledge via conferences led by local & national actors of the field.
