What's on in Normandy?



To commemorate the 78th anniversary of the D-Day landings, different towns **around Normandy** are participating in the **D-Day Festival** from **28 May to 12 June**. Exhibitions, guided tours, reconstitutions of military camps, picnics, markets, re-enactments, parades, concerts, fireworks... Many events are taking place from Utah Beach to Sword Beach.
