
What's on in Normandy?

You will be able to visit, for free, 42 vessels and tall ships coming from all around the world and enjoy free concerts, sporting activities and fireworks every night.

The **D-Day Landings Marathon** will celebrate its 36th edition from **2 to 4 June**. Also known as the Marathon for Freedom, it gathers more than 20,000 participants every year taking part in 7 races (running, walking, rollerblading) which cross emblematic places of the Battle of Normandy **in Calvados** such as Juno and Sword Beach, Ouistreham, Pegasus Bridge...
